ISBRA 2010 is the world congress on alcohol research held every two years. The 2010 ISBRA Congress will be held at CAP 15 Conference Centre in Paris, France, from September 13 to 16, 2010.

The ISBRA Congress will be followed on September 17, 2010 by the ESBRA Nordmann Award Meeting in Heidelberg, Germany and complemented by other connected events.

The World Congress in 2010 welcomes ISBRA members, as well as scientific and clinical colleagues from around the world. The program will have relevance to laboratory scientists, clinicians who treat alcohol-related disorders, clinical researchers and policy makers.

The International Program Committee is sculpting a congress with world-renowned plenary speakers each morning, and up to 72 symposia, workshops and roundtable discussion sessions. Many of the symposia will have participating young scientists and there will be clinical sessions.

Specific symposia topics are shown in the preliminary program timetable. The topics represented, and the balance of the overall conference program, will be determined by the proposals submitted for consideration. However, it is anticipated that the question of pre-

vention and care policies in France compared to other countries, and also alcohol and violence, sponsored by the Société Française d'Alcoologie, will be discussed on Monday the 13<sup>th</sup> and Tuesday the 14<sup>th</sup>.

There will be provision for up to 400 posters presentations.
